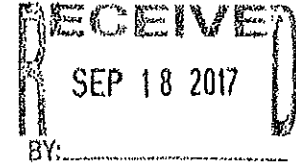

RESOLUTION No. 2017-04

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE BELIEF OF THE LONDONDERRY TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS THAT CHESTER WATER AUTHORITY SHOULD NOT BE SOLD TO A PRIVATE ENTITY, AND SUPPORTING THE DECISION OF THE CURRENT CHESTER WATER AUTHORITY'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS TO REJECT THE PROPOSAL OF AQUA AMERICA, INC.

WHEREAS, Londonderry Township's Board of Supervisors support the unanimous decision of the Board of Directors of the Chester Water Authority ("CWA BOARD") to reject the proposal of Aqua America to purchase CWA's assets and customers.

WHEREAS, Londonderry Township's Board of Supervisors request that the CWA Board does not sell its customers and assets to a for-profit company.


WHEREAS, Londonderry Township requests that the CWA Board continue to protect our Township residents and businesses by putting the interests of the ratepayers first when making decisions about the Authority's operations and future.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,


1. Londonderry Township, Board of Supervisors pledge to continue to support the mission of the Chester Water Authority and protect the interests of the residents of Londonderry Township and
