

ORDER

AND NOW, this 6th day of August, 2019, upon consideration of the Court’s Order dated August 6, 2019 entered in the related matter Orphans’ Court Matter docketed at 217-2019 (hereinafter referred to as “Orphans’ Court Matter”) prohibiting any action with regard to the disposition or transfer of assets that are also at issue in the above-captioned matter, the Court’s recognition of the necessity of maintaining the *status quo*, and upon having held a hearing on August 6, 2019, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **DECREED** that any and all terms of the Amended Order entered July 2, 2019 by Judge James P. Bradley, as extended by this Court’s Order of August 1, 2019, enjoining the City of Chester specifically “from alienating any assets owned by or allegedly owned by the Chester Water Authority[,]” are **EXTENDED** for thirty (30) days or until further Order of the Court.
