

Statement from the Chester County Commissioners:

We appreciate and understand the concerns of many Chester County residents regarding any potential sale of the Chester Water Authority to a private water utility company. We agree that the sale of Chester Water Authority to a private water utility company is not in the best interest of the Authority nor its ratepayers – our businesses and residents. The County has taken an active role in the on-going litigation about this very issue and will fight to keep Chester Water Authority a public entity.

In 2017, our three board appointees voted against privatization. Two of those same board members are still our appointees to Chester Water Authority's Board. While we do not direct the way they vote, they know they have the full support of the Board of Commissioners to continue voting against any privatization attempts. As we look to fill the Chester County vacancy on the Board, a key value we look for is someone who will passionately support keeping Chester Water Authority a public utility.
